

Pfizer 5-<12 COVID-19 Vaccination Consent Form

Qualifying criteria of vaccination

Every Australian aged 5 to 11 (inclusive) can now have the Pfizer vaccine through their GP.

My child is 5 to 11 years old.

Contraindications

There are only two contraindications to COVID-19 Vaccines for children aged 5-<12 years of age: hypersensitivity or anaphylaxis reaction to any of the active substances or to any of the other ingredients within the vaccine or to a previous dose of the same vaccine.

I confirm my child has not had anaphylaxis to any of the covid vaccine ingredients or a previous covid vaccine¹

Side effects

Common adverse events include: Inj. site tenderness (>80%), Fatigue (>50%), Headache (>30%), Muscle Aches/Pains & Chills (>10%), Diarrhoea, Vomiting, Joint Pain, Fever. Uncommon side effects include: Swollen Lymph nodes, Rashes, Decreased Appetite, Nausea, Malaise.

Rare side effects (such as myocarditis and pericarditis) can occur, but they are rare (with an individual's risk dependent on multiple factors including age).

I confirm I am accepting of the risks and wish to continue with the vaccination.

I confirm my child has not had any other vaccination within the last 7 days.

I confirm myself and my child have been informed as to the risks of COVID-19 vaccination and I wish to receive the vaccination.

¹ *Each 0.2 mL dose contains 10mcg COVID-19 mRNA embedded in lipid nanoparticles, ((4-hydroxybutyl)azanediyl)bis(hexane6,1-diyl)bis(2-hexyldecanoate) (ALC-0315), 2-[[poly(ethylene glycol)-2000]-N, N-ditetradecylacetamide (ALC-0159), Distearoylphosphatidylcholine (DSPC), Cholesterol, Trometamol, Tromeyamol hydrochloride, Sucrose, Water for injection
